Carl Leland Jackson, 80, of West Burlington, died at 2:35 p.m. Sunday, May 28, 2017, at Great River Medical Center in West Burlington.

Born on August 22, 1936 in Davis County, Iowa, he was the son of Carl Larue and Leola Georgia (Lough) Jackson. On February 18, 1956, he married Vera Maxine Edler. She died March 29, 2011.

Carl served in the Army Reserves for over 14 years.

Carl worked in maintenance with the City of West Burlington for over 18 years. He served as Mayor of West Burlington for two terms from 1974 - 1977. He and Barb Bengé were instrumental in establishing the Westland Mall. He previously worked for IAAP for 14 years, owned

his own Jackson Painting and Construction for over 30 years, and built homes in Montrose for four years. He was recently recognized as Grand Marshall in the annual 4th of July parade in West Burlington.

He enjoyed working in his shop, working on racecars with Dennis LaVeine and riding Harleys. He was a well-known man and he loved spending time with his many friends and family. His great passion was spending time on the island.

Survivors include two sons, Nick Jackson of Belle Fourche, SD and Rick Jackson of Burlington; one grandchild, Tyler Jackson; one great grandson, Bentlee and one sister, Helen Sample of Bloomfield, IA.

He was preceded in death by his parents, his wife Maxine, one grandson Matthew Jackson, and one sister Thelma McConahay.

The family will receive friends from 5 until 7 p.m. Friday, June 9th, at Lunning Chapel.

The funeral service for Mr. Jackson will be 2 p.m. Saturday, June 10th, at Lunning Chapel with Pastor Charles Stevens officiating. Interment will be in Burlington Memorial Park Cemetery. The Burlington Area Veterans Honor Guard will conduct military rites.
